## What is Energy Upgrade California?

Energy Upgrade California™ is a statewide program designed to help homeowners make energy-efficient upgrades to reduce energy use, conserve natural resources and create more comfortable and efficient homes.

### How does the program work?

It's simple. Just choose from a list of participating contractors who will guide you through the upgrade process. Your certified Energy Upgrade California contractor will:

- Perform a comprehensive home energy assessment using the latest state-of-the-art technologies
- Help you select the Energy Upgrade package that will save the most energy and maximize your incentives
- Complete your energy-saving upgrades
- Help you apply for rebates, incentives and available financing

### Who can participate?

Currently, only single-family, owner-occupied homes\* are eligible for the Energy Upgrade California incentive.

\*New construction, multi-family and rental units are not eligible.

### Basic Upgrade package

The Basic Upgrade Package includes six required measures that together can reduce your energy consumption by an average of 10%. The fixed incentive is \$1,000.

- › Air sealing
- › Attic insulation
- › Duct sealing
- › Hot water pipe insulation
- › Thermostatic shut off valve
- › Combustion safety testing

### Advanced Upgrade package

The Advanced Upgrade Package is a customized energy efficiency solution for your home based on an energy assessment by a participating Energy Upgrade California contractor. Incentives range from \$1,250 - \$4,000.

- › High-efficiency furnace
- › Energy-efficient cooling
- › Water heater system
- › Energy-efficient windows
- › Duct replacement
- › Wall insulation
- › Energy-efficient lighting fixtures
- › Other custom energy-saving measures
