- Is SDG&E willing to share an advance copy of the Exclusivity Agreement for information?
 Answer: The exclusivity agreement will be available for download from Power Advocate.
 The agreement posting date will be announced on SDG&E's RFI website by October 11th.
- What is the anticipated exclusivity collateral amount? Answer: \$2/KWh
- 4. Is there a maximum and/or minimum volume that SDG&E will entertain for this RFI? (MW and MWh)

Answer: No required minimum/maximum to participate in this RFI.

5. Can different projects be submitted on individual tabs (each with their respective milestones tabs) within the same workbook?

Answer: Please submit a separate workbook for each project.

6. Is SDG&E willing to disclose how many points (FCDS and Energy-Only) they have been allocated?

Answer: SDG&E's MW allocation can be found on CAISO's interconnection request and study webpage.

7. Could SDG&E please clarify question 5.K: Is 90% or more site control of land also a requirement to develop the relevant gen-tie?
Answer: The question relates to whether the gen-tie is part of the Project site or other

adjacent land. If other adjacent land, please describe the plan in the notes section.
