

## California Climate Credit Bill Relief from the Cap-and-Trade Program

## A Message from the California Public Utilities Commission

This October\* your utility bill will include a \$78.22 electric credit identified as the "California Climate Credit." Your household and millions of others throughout the state will receive a similar credit on their electric bill.

The California Climate Credit is part of the State's Cap-and-Trade Program that requires polluters to pay for climate pollution. Credits are distributed in April and October each year. Credits appear automatically on your bill and are designed to help utility customers during the transition to a more sustainable future.
