- 2. Confirm or deny: the results of the "Demand Studies," which were the subject of workshops on May 23, 2019, were reflected in SDG&E's proposals in A.19-03-002. Please explain your response to this question and provide supporting documentation.
 - SDG&E Response: SDG&E's distribution demand charge study results are reflected in Chapter 5, the direct testimony of SDG&E witness William Saxe. The results of SDG&E's generation and transmission demand charge studies are not included in the Application's proposals. SDG&E's rate design proposals in Chapter 3, the direct testimony of SDG&E witness Morien, do not reflect the results of the studies. SDG&E's rate design proposals for distribution demand charges and generation demand charges maintain the current effective rate design that was adopted in SDG&E's 2016 GRC Phase 2, D.17-08-030.
- 3. At the workshop on May 23, 2019, at which the "Demand Studies" were discussed, SDG&E indicated that it would rerun its analysis (both its original and its alternate analyses) using revised Effective Demand Factors. Please indicate when those additional analyses will be completed. When the studies are completed, please provide those studies and all workpapers supporting the studies. Please ensure that all spreadsheets have live links and formulae intact.
